

Rapture “High Watch” Dates

“Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.” -(Revelation 3:10)

This is the last prophecy and promise of the Bible addressed to believers and followers of Jesus Christ of Nazareth before being called to ***“Come up hither”*** in Revelation 4:1.

We have three “high” watch dates coming up and so this is a reminder for those anxious for the Lord’s return.

April 30th/May 1st, Friday/Saturday would be God’s Special Day Nisan 17/18 under the Second Passover designated in the Bible. Blessed Hope #57 addressed this specific event in ample detail and explanation, which permitted an observance for a Second Passover event in the Hebrew Scriptures.

May 13th, a Thursday is recognized as the Ascension of the Lord after His resurrection appearances. Following the account of Acts 1:3 that the risen Jesus appeared for 40 days prior to his Ascension, Ascension Day is traditionally celebrated on a Thursday,

May 17th/18th is the Torah Calendar date for Pentecost and ought not to be overlooked as a high watch day.

May 23rd, a Sunday is recognized by the Church as Pentecost Sunday, which occurs 50 days after Resurrection Day or the pagan name of Easter, and the day empowering the birth of the physical body of the Church.

All three, for various reasons, are recognized as potential “high” watch days for the Lord to call us home, ***“Come up hither!”***

As a student of the Bible and history nearly 60 years, the world state of things have never been so primed for God’s “Deliverance” than they are at this very moment in time.
