

## Great Reset Will Require Trust in Invasive Surveillance Tech: WEF Promotes Health Passports & Contact Tracing

In order to bring about the great reset, it will require trust in the technology, and to be more specific, the WEF would like to have greater trust in "crisis-relevant tech," which includes developing digital health passports and contact tracing, under a new form of internet governance.

"The Great Reset will require new institutions and business models, and new digital technologies to build them," wrote the WEF Head of Corporate Governance and

Trust, Daniel Dobrygowski, in a blog post. "The necessary collaboration, however, is only possible if we solve the digital trust problem," he added.

According to the Dobrygowski, "The use of digital technology during the COVID-19 crisis offers clear lessons," one of those being, "Target mistrust broadly to enable specific crisis-relevant tech."

The WEF openly supports the development of so-called "crisis-relevant tech" as evidenced by its backing the development of health passports, which act as digital records of your health status to determine whether or not you are free to travel or even go outside.

Earlier in 2020, the WEF announced it was supporting the development and launch of CommonPass — a platform whose mission is "to develop and launch a standard global model to enable people to securely document and present their COVID-19 status (either as test results or an eventual vaccination status) to facilitate international travel and border crossing while keeping their health information private."

The WEF also lent its support to another health passport initiative called CovidPass, which was built by one of the WEF's own "Young Global Leaders," Mustapha Mokass, who used to be an advisor at the World Bank.

<u>CovidPass</u> "uses block chain technology to store encrypted data from individual blood tests, allowing users to prove that they have tested negative for COVID-19."

In supporting both CommonPass and CovidPass, the Davos elite made it clear they want "crisis-relevant tech" like health passports to be part of the great reset solution.

Ask yourself, would the idea of being forced to electronically prove your current health status in order to travel or even leave your own home have been acceptable before 2020?

The die was cast years ago, but only during COVID-19 did the Davos elite see a shrinking, yet golden opportunity, to create a new world order out of the coronavirus chaos.

- 2. OPEC responds with an oil embargo.
- 3. Iran closes the straits of Hormuz.
- 4. The price of oil reaches \$300/barrel.
- 5. Europe succumbs into a full-blown energy crisis due to LNG shortage.

- 6. Massive spike in energy prices reinvigorates inflation with central banks responding accordingly.
- 7. Financial markets and the global banking sector collapse.
- 8. Debt crisis engulfs the U.S. forcing the Federal Reserve to enact yet another financial market bailout.
- 9. Petrodollar trade collapses.
- 10. Hyperinflation emerges.

U.S. Secretary of Defense Lloyd Austin announced on Saturday that Washington is dispatching a second aircraft carrier, the USS Eisenhower, to the Eastern Mediterranean "to deter hostile actions against Israel or any efforts toward widening this war following Hamas's attack."

In an official statement, Austin said the United States has an "ironclad commitment to Israel's security and our resolve to deter any state or non-state actor seeking to escalate this war."

While not mentioning any specific actors, the military dispatch is widely seen as a warning to the Iranian regime and its Lebanese terror proxy Hezbollah against attacking Israel from the north while it is fighting against Hamas terrorists in Gaza.

The USS Eisenhower warship convoy will join the USS Ford aircraft carrier that was sent earlier in an effort by Washington to prevent the Gaza war from expanding throughout the Middle East region.

America is Israel's closest ally and the Biden administration has rallied behind the Jewish state and defended its right to self-defense against the atrocities committed by the Hamas terror organization.

During his recent visit to Israel, U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken stressed that the United States will always support Israel.

"The message that I bring to Israel is this: You may be strong enough on your own to defend yourself, but as long as America exists, you will never, ever have to. We will always be there by your side. That's the message that President Biden delivered to the prime minister from the moment that this crisis began," Blinken vowed.

The top U.S. diplomat also blasted many in the international community for failing to condemn the unprecedented terror attack against Israeli civilians, which claimed the lives of 1,300 Israeli men, women and children.

"There is no excuse, there is no justification for these atrocities," Blinken said. "This is, this must be, a moment for moral clarity," he added.

Turkey's President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan failed to condemn the Hamas massacre of civilians on Oct. 7. Instead, the Turkish leader blasted Israel's legitimate right to self-defense actions against Hamas as "shameful."

Erdoğan repeated his false accusation that Israel bombs civilians in Gaza.

"Bombing civilian sites, killing civilians, blocking humanitarian aid and trying to present these as achievements are the acts of an organization and not a state," he said.

Israel Defense Forces are, in fact, striking Hamas military targets while seeking to minimize civilian casualties. Hamas, however, is reportedly using Gazan civilians as human shields while murdering Israeli civilians, a double war crime.

The Turkish leader's false statement about Israel's military operations comes after Turkey, itself, recently bombed civilian and military targets in northeast Syria in its war against Kurdish militants.

Meanwhile, the Iranian ayatollah regime that supports Hamas threatened the Jewish state with "consequences" if it did not stop its military operation against the terror group that operates in the Gaza Strip.

"If the Israeli apartheid's war crimes & genocide are not halted immediately, the situation could spiral out of control & ricochet far-reaching consequences—the responsibility of which lies with the UN, the Security Council & the states steering the Council toward a dead end," Iran's permanent UN mission wrote on X, formerly Twitter.

The Iranian ayatollah regime openly calls for Israel's destruction and has invested considerable resources in its terror proxies Hezbollah, Hamas and Palestinian Islamic Jihad along Israel's northern and southern borders.

A senior Israeli official accused Iran on Sunday of trying to open a second war front by deploying weapons in or through Syria as Israel steps up a <u>counter-offensive in Gaza</u> to the south.

Responding to a post on the X social-media platform that posited such a scenario, Joshua Zarka, head of strategic affairs for Israel's Foreign Ministry, said: "They (Iranians) are."

The original post also said *"the Israelis are determined to prevent"* such developments. To that, Zarka responded: *"We are."*

**THE "DEPARTURE IN 2 THESSALONIANS 2:3 - Pre-Trib** Dr. Ice's paper is everything you need to know that we will be taken out before Daniel 9:27 is fulfilled. It is centered in the dates of COP28 and so we have an approximate date.

Dr. Andy Woods wrote a book on this very topic, 'The Falling Away: Spiritual Departure or Physical Rapture' in 2018.

At one time, the 'Arab-Israeli Conflict' was Arab and Israeli. Over the course of many years, however, it was rebranded. The media is now telling us it is a 'Hamas-Israeli conflict'. Most people see it as political when it is really a Biblical prophecy issue that was to make Israel a "Cup of Trembling" for the world. "Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem." -(Zechariah 12:2)

I know that few people understand what I am saying but it is due to their ignorance of the Bible.

But what went wrong? Israel simply became too powerful.

The supposedly astounding Israeli victories over the years against Arab armies have emboldened Israel to the extent that it came to view itself, not as a regional superpower, but as a global power as well. Israel, per its own definition, became 'invincible'.

Such terminology was not a mere scare tactic aimed at breaking the spirit of Palestinians and Arabs alike. Israel believed this.

The 'Israeli miracle victory' against Arab armies in 1967 was a watershed moment. Then, Israeli ambassador to the United Nations, Abba Eban, declared in a speech that "from the podium of the UN, I proclaimed the glorious triumph of the IDF and the redemption of Jerusalem."

This, in his thinking, could only mean one thing: "Never before has Israel stood more honored and revered by the nations of the world." Jews are arrogant people. If you ask people who have worked for Jewish employers, they know what I am saying. In my secular employment days, I have worked for some very demanding Jews and their arrogance reeks of superiority of mindset and attitude. The "Chosen People" Syndrome does not reflect in their humility virtue of gratitude or thankfulness. Scripture shows that God punished them by taking from them their revered Temple, Land, and Torah when He sent them into 70 years of captivity in Babylon.

The sentiment in Eban's words echoed throughout Israel. Even those who doubted their government's ability to completely prevail over the Arabs, joined the chorus: Israel is unvanguishable.

Little rational discussion took place back then, about the actual reasons why Israel had won, and if that victory would have been possible without Washington's complete backing and the West's willingness to support Israel at any cost.

Israel was never a graceful winner. As the size of territories controlled by the triumphant little state increased by three-fold, Israel began entrenching its military occupation over whatever remained of historic Palestine. It even began building settlements in newly occupied Arab territories, in Sinai, the Golan Heights and all the rest.

Fifty years ago, in October 1973, Arab armies attempted to reverse Israel's massive gains by launching a surprise attack. They initially succeeded, then failed when the U.S. moved guickly to bolster Israeli defenses and intelligence.

It was not a complete victory for the Arabs, or a total defeat for Israel. The latter was badly bruised, though. But Tel Aviv remained convinced that the fundamental relationship it had established with the Arabs in 1967 had not been altered.

And, with time, the 'conflict' became less Arab-Israeli and more Palestinian-Israeli. Other Arab countries, like Lebanon, paid a heavy price for the fragmentation of the Arab front.

This changing reality meant that Israel could invade South Lebanon in March 1978, and then sign the Camp David Peace Accords with Egypt, six months later.

While the Israeli occupation of Palestine grew more violent, with an insatiable appetite for more land, the west turned the Palestinian struggle for freedom into a 'conflict' to be managed by words, never by deeds.

Many Palestinian intellectuals make a point of arguing that "this is not a conflict", that military occupation is not a political dispute, but governed by clearly defined international laws and boundaries. And that it must be resolved according to international justice.

That is yet to happen. Neither was justice delivered, nor an inch of Palestine was retrieved, despite the countless international conferences, resolutions, statements, investigations, recommendations, and special reports. Without real enforcement, international law is mere ink.

But did the Arab people abandon Palestine? The anger, the anguish, and the passionate chants by endless streams of people who took to the streets throughout the Middle East to protest the annihilation of Gaza by the Israeli army, did not seem to think that Palestine is alone – or, at least, should be left fighting on its own.

The isolation of Palestine from its regional context has proven disastrous. There is probably more Jewish blood among the Palestinian people than there are in Israel itself where 85% of the population is Ashkenazi and not descendant of Biblical Jews from Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. In the Blessed Hope #215, I noted that the Rothschild's purchase 90,000 acres of Palestine from the Greek Orthodox Sursock family they had acquired from the poor peasants who shepherd the land.

When the 'conflict' is only with the Palestinians, then Israel determines the context and scope of the so-called conflict, what is allowed at the 'negotiations table', and what is to be excluded. This is how the Oslo Accords squandered Palestinian rights. It may have been a secondary issue when Yasser Arafat walked away from the table in the Oslo Accords.

The more Israel succeeds in isolating Palestinians from their regional environs, the more it invests in their division.

It is even more dangerous when the conflict becomes between Hamas and Israel. The outcome is a whole different conversation that is superimposed on the truly urgent understanding of what is taking place in Gaza, in the whole of Palestine at the moment.

In Israel's version of events, the war began on October 7, when Hamas fighters attacked Israeli military bases, settlements, and towns in the south of Israel.

No other date or event prior to the Hamas attack seems to matter to Israel, to the West and to corporate media covering the war with so much concern for the plight of Israelis, and complete disregard to the Gaza inferno.

No other context is allowed to spoil the perfect Israeli narrative of Daesh-like Palestinians disturbing the peace and tranquility of Israel and its people.

Palestinian voices that insist on discussing the Gaza war within proper historical contexts – the ethnic cleansing of Palestine in 1948, the occupation of Jerusalem, the West Bank and Gaza in 1967, the siege on Gaza in 2007, and all the bloody wars before and after – are simply denied platforms.

The pro-Israel media simply does not want to listen. Even if Israel did not go as far as making unfounded claims about decapitated babies, the media would have remained committed to the Israeli narrative, anyway.

Yet, if Israel continues to define the narratives of war, historical contexts of 'conflicts', and the political discourses that shape the West's view of Palestine and the Middle East, it will continue to obtain all the blank checks necessary to remain committed to its military occupation of Palestine. In turn, this will fuel yet more conflicts, more wars and more deception regarding the roots of the violence.

For this vicious cycle to break, Palestine must, once more, become an issue that concerns all Arabs, the whole region. The Israeli narrative must be countered, western bias confronted, and a new, collective strategy formed.

In other words, Palestine cannot be left alone anymore.

Unfortunately that is not going to happen as tempers boil and rage seethes in Israel's neighbors over what Israel plans to do in the Gaza. I watched a video where six or seven high rises were brought down in a cloud of black dust and debris.

Hal Turner posted an interesting report overnight in Israel there have been developments. First, water mains were turned back on from Israel into southern Gaza. Next, Egypt has re-opened the Rafah Border Crossing to AMERICANS to exit Gaza. A ground invasion has \*\*not\*\* begun.

It is also very clear there have been Few attacks on Gaza in the last 36 hours, and few missile from Gaza too. I'm sensing that there might be serious reconsideration by Israel of the existential reality facing them.

Iran was not kidding when it said "Unless the offensive against Gaza stops, we will intervene." Hezbollah in Lebanon is not kidding, they're making small incursions into northern Israel, hitting IDF Troops, and then retreating.

Syria is clearly arming-up its regular army since last night's Israeli missile attacks on Damascus and Aleppo Airports - again - the second time within days.

The fact that Israel had not gone in last night spawned RUMORS the fighter jets had to wait because . . . . get this . . . . thunderstorms were coming to the area, and they affected pilot's ability to hit ground targets. Most know that's complete bullshit - fighter jets operate in all weather and in full nightfall.

So clearly something is "up" with what's taking place over there.

Most obvious (to me) is that Israel seems to be waiting for the USS Dwight D. Eisenhower aircraft carrier and its Strike Group to arrive on-station along with the USS Gerald R. Ford and its Strike group which is already there.

Once the Eisenhower arrives, the U.S. will have, off Israel's coast:

- 2 aircraft carriers
- At least 160 aircraft.
- Two guided missile cruisers,
- Six destroyers

Once the NATO Maritime Surface Group #2 arrives, the TOTAL firepower off Israel's coast will include:

- 2 Aircraft Carriers

   USS Dwight D. Eisenhower (CVN-69)
- 2 Ticonderoga-Class Cruisers USS Normandy (CG-60)

USS Carney (DDG-64)

USS Roosevelt (DDG-80)

- 1 Type-45 Air Defense Destroyer HMS Duncan (D-37)
- 5 Frigates ESPS Méndez Núñez (F-104) FS Surcouf (F-711) ITS Carlo Margottini (F-592) TCG Yavuz (F-240) HS Psara (F-454)
- 2 Landing Support Ships RFA Lyme Bay RFA Argus

These vessels and their enormous firepower are in addition to:

- Additional F-35s, F-15, F-16s and A-10s. (And that's what's been added to already present aircraft assets.)

Recall, too, the USS George Washington and the HMS Prince of Wales (A Queen Elizabeth class aircraft carrier) both pulled out of Norfolk, VA last week, at least two days BEFORE the Dwight D. Eisenhower departed. And no one is revealing where the Washington and the Prince of Wales are heading.

Factor-in that NATO revealed two days ago that its Maritime Surface Group 2 was heading toward the Mediterranean Sea as of Friday as well.

Ships can't move very fast relative to the distances they must cover; it takes time to get these enormous fleets into position.

Which begs the question: In position for what, exactly?

GAZA is smaller than the City of Chicago. Israel has its regular Army and another 360,000 reserve troops already called up. In addition to the above, the 101st Airborne Division was shuttled from the Ukraine area to Jordan last week.

How much manpower and firepower does Israel need for a place that's smaller than Chicago?

Unless, of course, this isn't just about Gaza at all. Perhaps this is about Iran and Syria as well?

If we add those two countries into the mix, all of a sudden, the naval power being brought to the region starts to make more sense.

Israel has had it in for Iran for decades, and has whined, moaned, complained and accused about Iran to anyone and everyone, for years.

Syria is still blocking proposed construction of a Gas Pipeline from Qatar to Europe, and the west still wants that pipeline, so in the West's minds, Bashar Assad has to go.

Then, too, public opposition to ISRAEL has been a very sharp, well-placed political jab that has knocked the elite onto their back foot. The public outpouring of opposition to Israel (and to a lesser degree, support for Gaza) has been startling to the elite. They've never seen anything like it before. The elite's "narrative" about the ongoing fighting, is \*\*not\*\* being believed by the general public.

That fraud about "40 babies beheaded" fell like a lead balloon because everyone remembers the phony "Babies taken from incubators and thrown on the floor" lie during the Iraq invasion of Kuwait. That lie was exposed, albeit very late, and nobody is falling for that propaganda crap anymore.

Some people are saying "Oh look, it's the same tactics and lies they used during the Iraq war" and those people are right!

Threats aren't working for the elite, either. The French Interior Minister is threatening five years in prison for anyone "supporting" HAMAS or displaying "Pro-Palestinian" flags, signs, etc. Yet the French people have taken to the streets by the hundreds-of-thousands, doing exactly what the French Interior Minister says they cannot.

In the UK, it's worse. No less than King Charles himself has publicly threatened UK citizens with "14 years in prison for supporting Hamas." The general public in the UK is - even today - pouring into the streets with Palestinian flags, signs, and banners of support, in direct defiance of His Majesty.

So the "elite" are stupefied; the public is not listening to them or to their narrative. The general public is rebelling. The police are trying to enforce these new rules, but even the cops are afraid because the crowds are so big and quite unruly.

This combination of developments over the past couple days, was absolutely \*\*not\*\* expected by the-powers-that-be (TPTB) and they have to fall back and re-think their

strategies.

Turning the water back on in Gaza is part of the re-think.

It turned out that over the past five years, GAZA installed de-salination plants, and numerous . . .get this . . . solar-powered private wells! When the water mains were turned off, Israel had only been supplying about six percent (6%) of Gaza water.

So they took a huge public relations (PR) hit over shutting off water, but in reality, what they did achieved almost nothing.

So the decision to turn the water back on is now seen as a PR stunt because their initial effort totally failed, but got them gigantic PR trouble and they're hoping to get some of the PR pressure off them by turning the water back on.

The other variable here is the one that is \*\*not\*\* supposed to be said out loud: Israel isn't nearly as tough as they want everyone to think.

500,000 troops! Merkava tanks! Armored Personnel Carriers! . . . but to date, the Israelis have only used fighter jets to bomb apartment buildings, and artillery to fire shells from a very safe distance away. Why is that?

Why haven't they gone in?

The IDF says publicly they're ready. They say publicly they are "in-position" and await a political decision to begin.

Yet that decision does not come. Why not?

Is it because they aren't nearly as tough as they would have everyone believe? Are they afraid?

Afraid of what traps may await them inside Gaza?

Afraid of Hezbollah - which kicked their butts back in 2005 - coming into the fight?

Afraid of Iran and Syria entering the fight?

Afraid that even moderate partner-in-peace, Egypt, has warned "Israel has brought our relationship to the breaking point?"

Whatever the facts, the immutable fact is that Israel has \*\*not\*\* entered Gaza for an invasion - yet.

Or is it something other than fear. Is it arrogance? Are the Israeli's waiting for American and NATO firepower to arrive so that the "Goyim" will do the fighting FOR

#### THEM?

#### HMMMMMMMMM.

There is, of course, one other possibility that I have not touched upon:

It could be that the ground offensive is 100% happening. But we aren't going to see a massive battle charge because GAZA is one big booby trap.

The IDF may have decided to take it very slowly and clear GAZA piece by piece. That will also show the world they are being careful and methodical and not just slaughtering.

This morning, they are also slowly pushing the population of Gaza to the south for the same reason - turning the water on there could be to both lure people in that direction and also give the impression they're not going to wipe out Gaza in one go.

Once they've got what's left of Hamas pushed up against the southern border it will get very hard.

Basically, this may be a measured pressure build-up rather than the "shock & awe" head-on charge a lot of us are expecting.

Whatever will be, I still have a terrible sense of foreboding over this situation - and Ukraine. The stakes are very high and if these things go wild-weasel, we will ALL be in a world of hurt.

Prep. Get your emergency food, water, medicines, fuel, generator and communications gear like CB or HAM radio. Better to prep and not need it, than to need it but not have it.


And get right with God. That's most important of all.
