## **The Enemy of My Enemy is My Friend**

This expression is the best label that I would place on the so-called Trump’s “deal of the century”. Islam is divided into two branches, and has historically been at war with each other for approximately 1,400 years when it was not at war with other non-Muslim nations. I have stated that it is not the one in which a treaty is signed with “the many” by the Antichrist. Some of us see this as a big deal but not quite for the same reasons, and it has prophetic significance.

President Trump had a grin on his face a mile wide as if it was his election night victory photo op. The very name, The Abraham Accord is further indication that much is on the line. The announcement of a peace treaty between Israel and the United Arab Emirates (UAE), is a big deal, but not as big as media pundits are making it. I will not go so far to say that it is a huge deal as some seem to think. It will be a precursor step to the Daniel 9:27 event. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo returned home after stops in Bahrain, Oman and Sudan apparently empty-handed with none of the conservative Arab nations willing for now to follow Abu Dhabi in normalizing ties with Israel.



This peace deal is being touted as the one that will make peace throughout the Arab world. For a while, it may appear to do exactly that but this peace deal will have far greater implications for future global war, a war the Bible says will end in Armageddon.

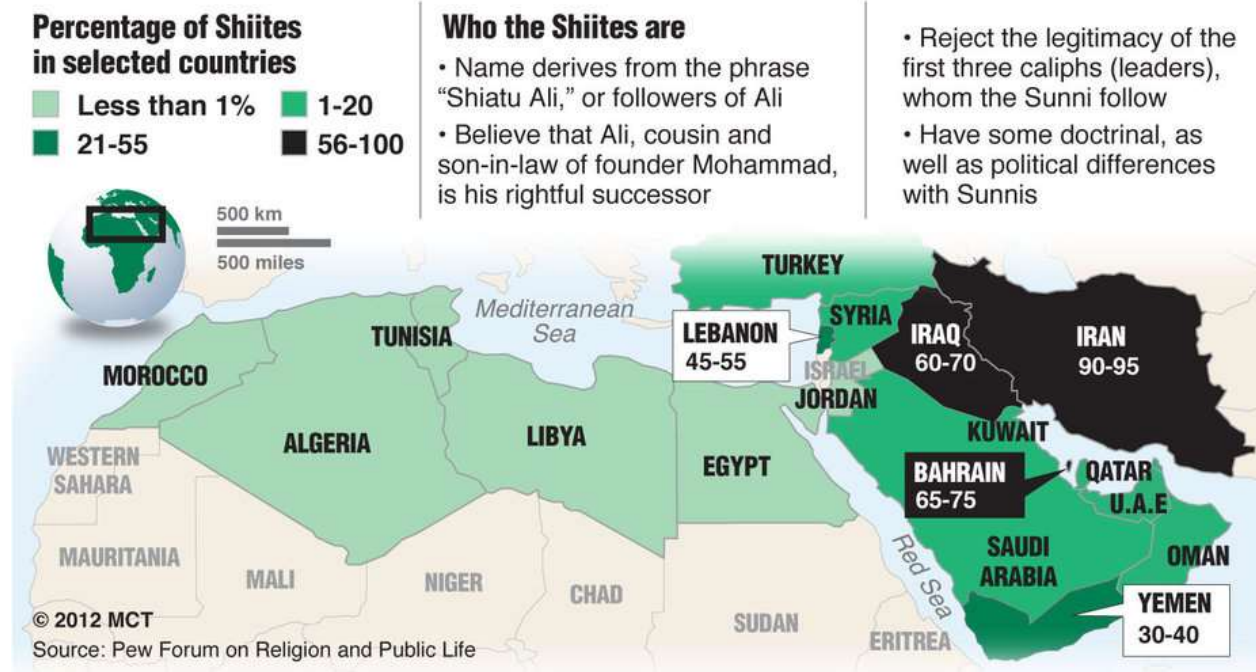
This peace deal has just set up the world for the fulfillment of the rise of Mystery Babylon and the world viewing the Antichrist as the messiah, That will include Jerusalem's coming destruction at the halfway point of the 7-year tribulation, the dispersion of Jews out of Israel, and Islam bursting forth in global war against infidels and ending in bloody Armageddon.

At least from a prophetic standpoint, the foundation for the "Huge" deal is bigger than we can imagine. Why so? How can this one event be a precursor to all of that? Because it is further evidence of the widening split between Sunnis and Shi'ites that will lead to global Islamic war. The UAE is leading the Sunni Arab nations into an alliance with Israel, the King of the South, which Iran, the King of the North, will destroy!

The King of the North has two groups of people as enemies. One enemy is almost 1,400 years old – that's the Sunnis. Iran is the remnant of Edom through Esau's grandson, Amalek, and leader of the Shi'ite Islamic sect. This sect has spent almost 1,400 years – 1388 years to be exact – trying to gain the Islamic succession from Mohammed. Sunnis and Shi'ites dislike each other intensely.

## Muslims in the Mideast

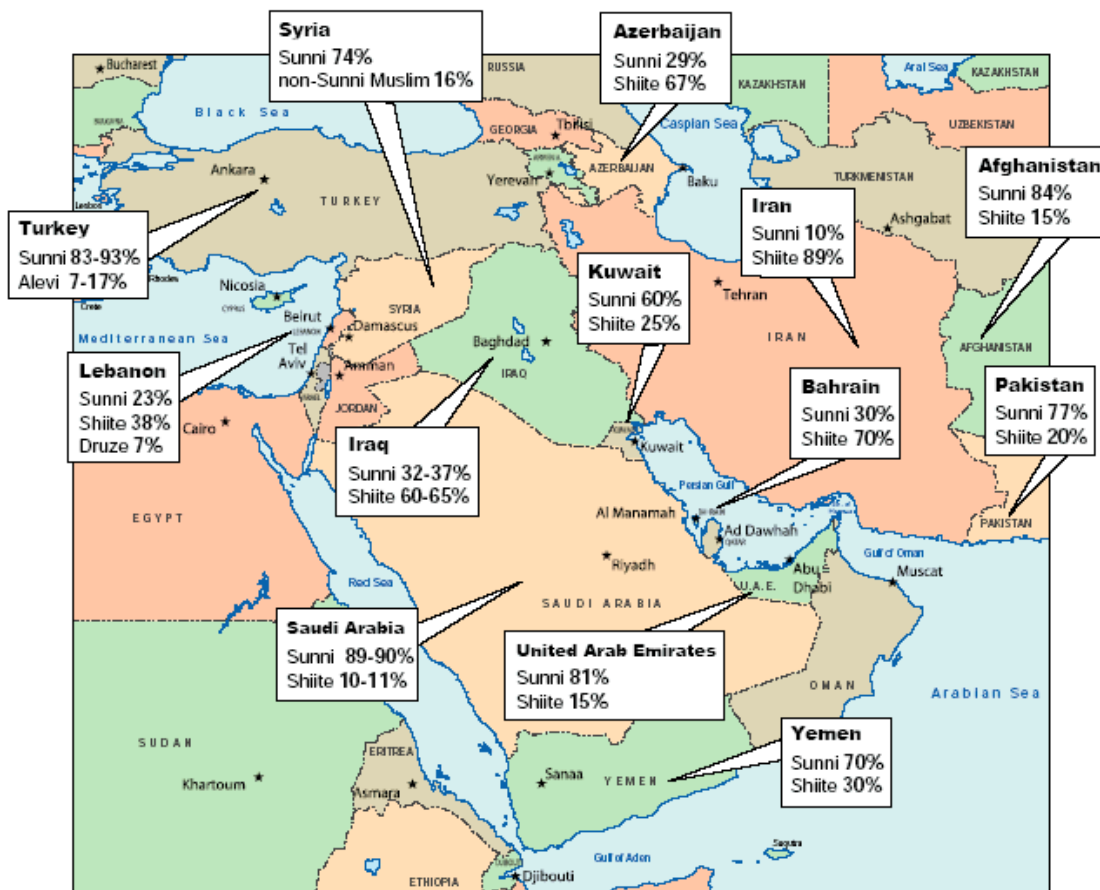
*Less than 15 percent of the world's Muslims are Shiite, or Shia; most Muslims are Sunni.*



The Abraham Accord formalizes relations between Iran's two enemies – Israel and the Sunni nation, the UAE, with possibly more to follow. The Middle East just lined itself up

for a huge north-south war with Iran's 4+2 coalition against Israel's southern Middle East coalition. For both Israel and the Sunni nations, this Accord is not one of making peace or desiring friendship, but one that justifies the old axiom "the enemy of my enemy is my friend". The map below provides a visual distribution of these two sects of Islam.

The map above, on page 2, is still valid despite it dates to 2012. Iran, Iraq, and Lebanon represent the Sunni faction, while Turkey, Syria, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Yemen, and Oman represent most of the Shia faction. To split these Muslim factions one has to wonder if The Abraham Accord did more to lay a trap than to divide and conquer the enemy of my enemy. I'm suggesting that the trap will eventually backfire on Israel.



The UAE lies just across the Persian Gulf from Iran in the Straits of Hormuz and views Iran as its enemy. This Accord provides for Israeli military defense with the major enemy in mind – Iran. Israel Hayom sums it up this way: *“The willingness of the Persian Gulf states to establish ties with Israel conveys the strength and reliability of the Jewish state in the eyes of the Arab nations. This is a dramatic regional achievement.”*

After Iran's 4+2 coalition King of the North invasion, nations like the UAE, Oman and Bahrain who are considering joining the Abraham Accord will then lie east of Iran's newly conquered territory, the entirety of the southern Middle East. In fact, Oman called

both the Israeli and Palestinian governments to talk about getting in on the history making. *Oman backed the Abraham Accord, brokered by the U.S., saying the decision will “contribute to fulfilling comprehensive, fair and durable peace in the Middle East.”*

This breakthrough, has with it Egypt’s blessing and Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan’s heartwarming rage, establishes the strategic axis of Israel, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, Jordan, Bahrain and Oman – and in other ways also Greece and Cyprus – against the radical regimes of Iran and Turkey. This is hugely provocative! This Israeli-Sunni alliance could push Turkey closer to Iran and Russia until the day comes when the Shi’ite nations establish Daniel’s 11<sup>th</sup> little horn, the coming Shi’ite Caliphate. That won’t sit well with the eastern Sunni nations whose ally, Israel, will have been destroyed by Iran. The eastern Sunni nations – eastern from Iran’s newly conquered territory – will reach out to Turkey immediately for defense support. Israel will be gone and Iran will now be an existential and immanent threat to those Sunni nations. Turkey’s response to its old Sunni allies will inflame Iran’s messiah, the Shi’ite Mahdi Antichrist, and Iran’s 4+2 coalition will go global in war through Iran’s allies, Russia and China who are chomping at the bit to get to America and her allies.

Morocco and Sudan have also expressed interest in the treaty. The King of the North will invade their territories in North Africa, too. These are also part of what Daniel 11:40-45 calls **“the countries”**, countries that did not exist in Daniel’s time.

The name of this new treaty is particularly telling - Abraham Accord. It may be that this peace treaty is suggesting that the Jewish Antichrist will confirm or strengthen when he takes office. I would bet big bucks on it. Jared Kushner and Mike Pompeo have largely been the White House operatives doing all the leg work on this deal, but as I alluded in my Blessed Hope #29, there is much more going on behind the scenes here than you can imagine, even going so far as to infer that an even larger deal is slated for late this fall, September around the Fall Feasts of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur! This announcement could take place as early as the next two weeks.

Daniel 9:27 **“And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week...”** The Hebrew text leaves us with the question about the meaning of the **“many”**. Some believe it refers to the Israeli government, the Knesset, while others believe it is referring to the southern Middle East’s and North Africa’s Sunni nations which are called “the countries” in Daniel chapter 11:40-45. This peace treaty will most likely be the umbrella deal, which I noted in Blessed Hope #28 and #29, under which the Jews will see clear their way to confirm or strengthen and enforce Judaism through Jewish law known as the Talmud.

This situation will likely go straight to Israel’s ego head, as it were. In fact, this deal probably symbolizes the crown on the rider on the white horse of Revelation 6:2. Let’s take a closer look to this passage. Revelation 6:2: **“And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.”**



# Sunnis and Shiites: Two forms of Islam

*Iraq's most senior Shia cleric has issued a call to arms, as Sunni-led Islamic State in Iraq and Syria (ISIS) threaten southern Iraq, dominated by the country's Shia Muslim majority. Although Shiites make up about 60 percent of the country, they constitute only about 10 percent to 20 percent of Muslims worldwide. Neighboring Iran has the world's largest Shiite population.*

## Origin of the schism

After the Prophet Muhammad's death in 632, a disagreement arose over who should succeed him as leader of Islam; two main factions emerged, creating a rift that remains almost 14 centuries later

Shiites believe that Muhammad's cousin and son-in-law, Ali, was his rightful successor, and that Ali's descendants are the true leaders of Islam

Sunnis believe that Muhammad's most pious companions were his rightful successors, and that the leaders of Islam may be chosen by consensus

The white horse represents a pseudo-religious purity, a religious idea of purity. White war horses symbolize a “religiously pure conqueror”. This horse and rider are against God and His people because God’s people wear white garments to symbolize their purity, garments made possible to be white through washing them in the blood of the Lamb. War and purity are nowhere to be found together in Scripture.

Everything we know about this Trump “plan of the century” has been orchestrated by the President’s son-in-law Jared Kushner and Secretary of State Mike Pompeo. 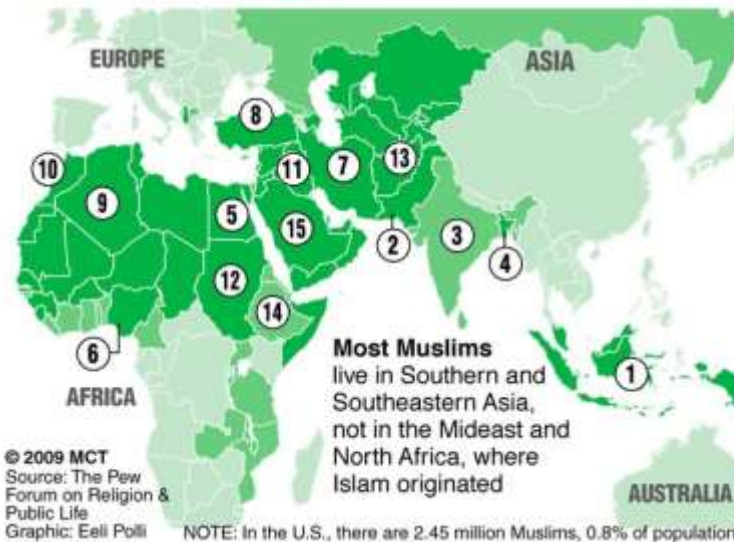
Now notice that this rider wears the crown of a king that was given to him. The crown was given to him by God for the purpose of bringing an end to the world's wickedness. God has always used the nations to do His bidding in dealing with His people. The UAE and other nations signing onto the Abraham Accord are doing so at God's behest. Neither the Jews nor the Sunnis see the coming trouble – the tribulation – that will come of all this intriguing chess game. Rather, they are saying “peace, peace”.

This rider is the counterfeit messiah. He is the Jewish Antichrist. How do we know this to be the case? It's the crown. He wears only one; the one that God gave to him. Jesus, however, wears many crowns -(Revelation 19:12). This one crown is now on the head of the rider of the white horse. He just hasn't mounted the horse yet. This one crown can now be identified through the name of the peace treaty “Abraham Accord”. The name appeals to Sunnis, Jews, and Christians and for the Shi’ites indicates that the Sunnis, Jews and Christians are the only children of Abraham which leaves out the Shi’ite connection to Abraham. You can or will see how this name will cause a problem for the Shi’ites and the Shi’ites will fight back! Esau knows he is related to Abraham and believes he is the rightful heir to the Promised Land!

Notice that the rider’s bow has no arrows. The bow without arrows symbolizes political victory. This rider is taking over the earth using politics and ideologies – Communist ideologies, to be exact! That is exactly what the U.S. and Israel are doing. Together, they are politicking Israel into global supremacy.

This rider goes forth **“conquering” and “to conquer”**. This is similar language to the King of the North who goes out “conquering” and “utterly to make away many”. 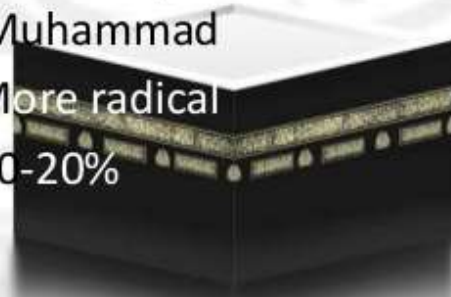

The chart above helps to define the issues dividing Islam, which is really important for those in the U.S. to understand. There is no such thing as a peaceful Muslim. One faction is simply more radical than the other. U.S. politicians and the American public are quick to dismiss this important distinction, a major error of judgment.

The Antichrist will tell the world when he takes office, i.e., confirm or strengthen (the Hebrew word is **'gabar'**, that this is the peace the earth has been waiting for and all the nations must adhere to it. The Jewish Antichrist riding the white religious horse, carrying the political bow without arrows and wearing only the one crown called the Abraham Accord will affirm that he is the king of Israel everyone has been waiting for and that he will now rule during the 1,000 year 'world to come' – he and his sons who he will claim are from the line of David. Tim Cohen pointed out years ago that Prince Charles had converted to Islam and had modified the term "Defender of the Faith" to that of "Defender of the Faiths"; such a step that will carry weight with the Islamic nations in the Middle East.

This horse and rider heralds the first half of the 7-year tribulation, the mechanism by which God will not only clean up His people but will remove any claim to His throne that any messiah may think he has whether it be Jewish or Edomite.



*According to a joint statement about the Abraham Accord, Israel and the UAE will exchange embassies and ambassadors, and they plan to “sign bilateral agreements regarding investment, tourism, direct flights, security, telecommunications, technology, energy, healthcare, culture, the environment...and other areas of mutual benefit”.*

Already, everyone is glowing that there is now a direct phone line between the UAE and Israel.

Netanyahu has said the UAE deal which is based on strength will yield ‘true peace’ with Palestinians. On Sunday, *Netanyahu heralded what he described as a new doctrine of a strong Israel that would seek peace with Arab nations rather than conditioning ties on first ending the conflict with the Palestinians by withdrawing from that territory.*

*“This historic change will also advance peace with the Arab world and, in the end, peace, true peace, monitored, secure, with the Palestinians as well,”* Netanyahu said.

*“It is different from those that preceded it in that it is based on two principles ‘Peace for peace,’ and ‘peace through strength,’”* Netanyahu said. *“Under this doctrine, Israel is not required to withdraw from any territory and together the two countries openly reap the fruits of a full peace: Investments, trade, tourism, health, agriculture, environmental protection and in many other fields, including defense of course,”* he said.

The effort to achieve that goal picked up speed 17 months ago at a US-led conference in Warsaw, according to officials involved.

That February 2019 meeting, originally conceived as an anti-Iran gathering, morphed into a broader Mideast security endeavor after European objections to its agenda. Many countries opted not to send their top diplomats, and Russia, China, and the Palestinians skipped it entirely. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu attended, however, as did the foreign ministers of key Arab states.

At the summit, diplomats from Saudi Arabia, the UAE, and Bahrain spoke of the threat Iran posed to their security and its use of Shiite proxies in Iraq, Syria, Lebanon, and Yemen. They stressed that confronting Iran had become the top priority – ahead of resolving the Israeli-Palestinian conflict – in comments appearing in a leaked video, whose authenticity was confirmed by a US official who attended the gathering.

Netanyahu followed, echoing similar concerns.

*“Iran was very high on the agenda in Warsaw because Iran’s foreign policy is the biggest driver of instability in today’s Middle East,”* outgoing US special envoy for Iran Brian Hook said.

Four months after the summit, a secret meeting between the UAE and Israel took place on June 17, 2019, in Washington.

The trilateral focused on regional, cyber and maritime security, as well as diplomatic coordination and disrupting terror finance, according to a US official who participated but was not authorized to discuss the matter publicly and spoke on condition of anonymity.

More meetings followed in the US, Israel, and the UAE capital of Abu Dhabi, culminating in Thursday's Trump announcement that his administration had brokered a deal between Israel and the UAE to establish diplomatic relations and exchange embassies. The UAE said Israel also agreed to halt its controversial plans to annex large areas of the occupied West Bank sought by the Palestinians.

Jared Kushner, Trump's son-in-law and senior adviser, told White House reporters that discussions for the deal took place over the past year and a half.

*"Look, at the end of the day, it's an inevitability, right?" Kushner said, adding later: "No Israeli has ever killed an Emirati, right? There's not that hatred between the people."*

To be sure, Israel and the UAE have never fought each other in war and do not share borders. Still, the agreement was far more warmly welcomed in Israel than the UAE, where the public has long viewed Israel with suspicion. But criticism has been muted, in part because of government suppression of free speech.

The UAE, composed of seven emirates run by hereditary rulers led by Abu Dhabi, will be only the third Arab nation, after Egypt and Jordan, to have full ties with Israel. By doing so, Abu Dhabi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Zayed laid a path for countries like Morocco, Bahrain, Oman, or Sudan to potentially follow.

There are many, though, who shun any Arab embrace of Israel. To the Palestinians, who say they had no prior notice of the deal, the UAE turned its back on the longstanding Arab consensus that recognition of Israel can only come after Israeli concessions in peace talks lead to the creation of a Palestinian state.

*"I think the UAE is least beholden to these old formulas of solidarity ... which gives them more strategic flexibility,"* said Kristin Smith Diwan, a scholar at the Arab Gulf States Institute in Washington.

### **Joint Statement of the United States, the State of Israel, and the United Arab Emirates / ABU DHABI, August 13, 2020 (WAM)**

President Donald J Trump, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu of Israel, and Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and Deputy Supreme Commander of the United Arab Emirates spoke today and agreed to the full normalization of relations between Israel and the United Arab Emirates.

This historic diplomatic breakthrough will advance peace in the Middle East region and is a testament to the bold diplomacy and vision of the three leaders and the courage of

the United Arab Emirates and Israel to chart a new path that will unlock the great potential in the region. All three countries face many common challenges and will mutually benefit from today's historic achievement.

Delegations from Israel and the United Arab Emirates will meet in the coming weeks to sign bilateral agreements regarding investment, tourism, direct flights, security, telecommunications, technology, energy, healthcare, culture, the environment, the establishment of reciprocal embassies, and other areas of mutual benefit. Opening direct ties between two of the Middle East's most dynamic societies and advanced economies will transform the region by spurring economic growth, enhancing technological innovation, and forging closer people-to-people relations.

As a result of this diplomatic breakthrough, and at the request of President Trump with the support of the United Arab Emirates, Israel will suspend declaring sovereignty over areas outlined in the President's Vision for Peace and focus its efforts now on expanding ties with other countries in the Arab and Muslim world. The United States, Israel, and the United Arab Emirates are confident that additional diplomatic breakthroughs with other nations are possible, and will work together to achieve this goal.

The United Arab Emirates and Israel will immediately expand and accelerate cooperation regarding the treatment of and the development of a vaccine for the coronavirus. Working together, these efforts will help save Muslim, Jewish, and Christian lives throughout the region.

The normalization of relations and peaceful diplomacy will bring together two of America's most reliable and capable regional partners. Israel and the United Arab Emirates will join with the United States to launch a Strategic Agenda for the Middle East to expand diplomatic, trade, and security cooperation. Along with the United States, Israel and the United Arab Emirates share a similar outlook regarding the threats and opportunities in the region, as well as a shared commitment to promoting stability through diplomatic engagement, increased economic integration, and closer security coordination. Today's agreement will lead to better lives for the people of the United Arab Emirates, Israel, and the region.

The United States and Israel recall with gratitude the appearance of the United Arab Emirates at the White House reception held on January 27, 2020, at which President Trump presented his Vision, and express their appreciation for United Arab Emirates' related supportive statements. The parties will continue their efforts in this regard to achieve a just, comprehensive and enduring resolution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. As set forth in the Vision for Peace, all Muslims who come in peace may visit and pray at the Al Aqsa Mosque, and Jerusalem's other holy sites should remain open for peaceful worshipers of all faiths. Prime Minister Netanyahu and Crown Prince Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed al Nahyan express their deep appreciation to President Trump for his dedication to peace in the region and for the pragmatic and unique approach he has taken to achieve it.

And, of course, mutual military support is always included in treaties.

Have you ever heard so many repeats of the word 'peace' in any speech by any world leader? Netanyahu spits the word out like pennies from a frog's mouth!

***“And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.”*** - (Revelation 16:13). Ahhh! Three nations, 3 unclean spirits – The United States, Israel and the UAE.

The new doctrine, he said, is *“in complete contradiction to the perception, until a few days ago, that no Arab country will agree to make formal and open peace with Israel before an end is achieved for the conflict with the Palestinians.”*

The end of the conflict with the Palestinians, out in the cold, will be the Gog-Magog war.

*“In effect, this mistaken concept gave the Palestinians a veto over achieving peace between Israel and Arab countries,”* he said.

*“It is precisely the expansion of reconciliation between Israel and the Arab world that is likely to promote Israeli-Palestinian peace,”* Netanyahu said. *“I see additional countries joining the circle of peace with us.”*

United Arab Emirates (UAE) Foreign Minister Anwar Gargash said that while his nation's request to buy advanced F-35 fighter jets from the United States predates the peace agreement with Israel which was announced a week ago, but the agreement will make it easier for the Emirates to purchase the aircraft.

*“The F-35, the UAE has already indicated that it wants the F-35 six years ago. It's already on the table. We have legitimate requests that are there, and we ought to get them. This is not, in my opinion, we ought to get them and the whole idea of a state of belligerency or war with Israel, and so I think it should actually be easier. But the F-35, as I've said, is a request that we made six years ago,”* Gargash said in an interview with the Washington-based Atlantic Council Thursday.

*“I do not know to what extent this [Israeli concern] stems from Israeli domestic politics,”* he said of the Israeli government's opposition to the UAE purchasing F-35 aircraft.

*‘Intellitimes’* reported Thursday that the concern is not that the UAE would use the F-35 against Israel, but that its possession of the aircraft could limit Israel's ability to operate against Iran.

The *‘New York Times’* reported today that US President Donald Trump has accelerated contacts with the UAE in recent weeks for the sale of the F-35 and other American-made aircraft.



A secret push by President Donald Trump's senior adviser Jared Kushner to sell advanced arms — including F-35 stealth fighter jets — to the United Arab Emirates has caused confusion and frustration among agencies and congressional committees that would normally be involved in such a sale but have been left in the dark.

Kushner is supporting the administration's discussions with the UAE about the potential advanced arms sale, which have been led by the NSC Senior Director for the Middle East, Miguel Correa, a senior administration official said.

The tight hold on details about these discussions has created confusion across the U.S. government, two State Department officials and multiple congressional aides tell CNN.

Trump said the potential sale was *"under review"* during a press conference on Wednesday. He also said the Emirates have the funds to pay for the military hardware. This Abraham Accord reeks of different agendas, and has had tacit support by the Arab/Muslim states since Benjamin Netanyahu decided not to annex the Jordan Valley, but also made it clear, annexation was still on the table. President Trump wants to sell U.S. military hardware to seal up the deal, but keep in mind, every time the U.S. arms countries, it often ends up with that weaponry being used against the U.S. or its allies.

In Daniel 9:24 we find that "reconciliation" is one of the areas God promises to His people will be fulfilled, will be cleaned up. This Abraham Accord is not the reconciliation of God but the Jewish Antichrist's mimicry of it. I am not saying Netanyahu is the Antichrist, I've simply made it abundantly clear that Prince Charles of Wales is. There is another man who will fill this role.

According to the *'Jewish Telegraph Agency'*, the Palestinians just lost a lot. *"Not only did they see their enemy sign another diplomatic accord without promising them anything, they also feel "sold out" by a country that was supposed to have their back," in the words of veteran Palestinian diplomat Hanan Ashrawi.*

For decades, Arab countries are united around the idea that Palestine must be liberated and Israel was not to be tolerated. Decades ago, as Israel continually proved its staying power and made strides toward peace with the Palestinians, Arab states began seeking an accommodation with the Jewish state — as long as the Palestinian issue was solved.

And now, the reason for all this fanfare over peace, over peace and over peace...Netanyahu said [Israel] has also achieved *"an unprecedented international influence"* by steadfastly opposing Iranian aggression in the region and its efforts to obtain nuclear weapons.

The *"unprecedented international influence"* is changing the world because Jerusalem is changing from Jerusalem, God's holy city, to Mystery Babylon, the global capital of Egyptian mystery religions mixed with Babylon's imperial (king-worshipping) government. In Mystery Babylon, you will worship like the King in those Egyptian

mysteries and you will worship the King of Israel who is also the Antichrist, the one who will kill you for upholding Christ Jesus as God and rightful King of Israel.

Not everyone is praising the new Accord. The normalization of diplomatic ties between Israel and the United Arab Emirates has variously been described as a “breakthrough” and an important staging moment towards a comprehensive Middle East peace.

These conclusions are, at best, premature, says *‘The Conversation.com.’*

Normalization of relations between Israel and an important Gulf state is a highly significant development whose fallout is unpredictable. What seems clear is that the UAE initiative will further deepen a regional divide. Trade with Israelis and of Israeli goods now permitted; teams due in Abu Dhabi on Monday for talks on aviation, tourism, trade, finance, health, energy and defense. The president of the United Arab Emirates on Saturday issued a decree abolishing a law boycotting Israel and allowing trade and financial agreements between the two nations, two days before a delegation from Jerusalem was due to arrive in Abu Dhabi in the wake of the August 13<sup>th</sup> normalization agreement.

The state-run WAM news agency said the move formally ending the boycott came on the orders of Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, the ruler of Abu Dhabi and the Emirates’ leader. WAM said the new decree allows Israelis and Israeli firms to do business in the UAE, a federation of seven sheikhdoms on the Arabian Peninsula. It also allows for the purchase and trade of Israeli goods.

In the Middle East, historic shifts rarely take place without unforeseen consequences. Israel’s pledge not to go ahead with the annexation of one-third of the West Bank and the Jordan Valley for the time being will be cold comfort for the Palestinians. I’m of the view that Jared Kushner and father-in-law, President Trump may have bitten off more than they can handle. They seem equally driven in seeing that Chabad Zionism get to build the third temple as if this will eliminate all the problems for Israel. If they can just get that temple built then they can claim their name a legacy in Middle East history.

So, we need to ask how this sets with Iran and Russia in the larger picture of Middle East history. As I was writing this, I was able to learn that Russia has 12 warships and two submarines in the eastern region of the Mediterranean Sea. You can safely conclude they are there as a sign of Russia’s projected power in the area they see as energy rich assets that can be grabbed at the opportune time.

The UAE has been quick to let Iran know that this agreement is not directed at Iran.

*Iran’s Rouhani said the UAE had made a “huge mistake” in reaching an agreement to normalize ties with Israel and called it a betrayal by the Gulf state.*

The Abraham Accord provides muscle-flexing by the Trump administration showing Iran that it needs to *bow down to the U.S. pressure if it wants relief across the region.*

One reason the Abraham Accord came about is because the Gulf countries recognized that Israel was one of the few powers that can challenge Iran, according to Tzachi Hanegbi, a minister in Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office.

Furthermore, the Abraham Accord further sets up the Gog-Magog war. Annexation has been "temporarily" taken off the table. Israel's Jews can't have peace with their Islamic Sunni neighbors while threatening to take all of Israel for themselves.

But Iran has a piece of the Israeli pie through being an ally of the Gazans and the Palestinians. In fact, Iran provides support and munitions to both Hamas and Islamic Jihad in Gaza as part of its Resistance Front forces and also supplies the Palestinians in the West Bank with munitions.

Iran is patiently waiting for Israel's F-16 fighter jets to swoop into Syria to attack, to be engaged by the Khordad-3 air defense systems, advanced technology manufactured in Iran. The Khordad-3 is similar to the Russian Buk anti-aircraft missile battery system.



Iran has already revealed that the first enemy, a U.S. stealth drone was shot down using the Khordad-3 system, with an operational range of about 75 and 105 kilometers to intercept airborne targets, equipped with a powerful phased array radar, the system can engage and intercept 4 active targets at each round.

Iran has deployed, based on satellite images, at least three Iranian-made Khordad-3 anti-aircraft missile systems on the Syrian-Lebanese border, the location of which is from where most of Israel's F-16 attacks are made into Syria. The Khordad-3 air defense systems are outfitted to hit hostile targets over the entire territory of Lebanon.

The Israeli military has not attempted to attack Syria for over a month, which means that the IDF is aware of the current situation, and is trying to overcome it.

The Iranian military tactics in Syria are changing and the appearance of their air defense systems in the region of Syria was not really a surprise, because official Tehran media announced the intentions to transfer its own air defense systems to Syria, and there's even talk about deploying the latest Iranian BAVAR-373 air defense systems there.

Iran (Persia in Ezekiel 38:5) will attack Israel by coming into Israel as part of Gog's enemy. The King of the North will attack Israel while they are busy fighting with the Palestinians and Gazans at some future point whose weapons have been supplied by Iran.

Israel's backing away from annexation of the West Bank provided the inroad to the Abraham Accord but it won't stop Iran from arming the Gazans and Palestinians to foment an internal war against Israel.

Interestingly so, Trump keeps saying annexation is off the table altogether while Netanyahu keeps saying annexation is only temporarily on hold. The annexation issue will continue to resurface through this process and it might be this issue that sparks the Gog-Magog war.

According to the *'Times of Israel'*, the news about the Abraham Accord provides a welcome distraction from the coronavirus problems [in Israel]. *The UAE-Israel deal has not yet even formally been consummated, but we have already entered the honeymoon period. After endless domestic political deadlocks, and months of a pandemic and a collapsing economy, Israeli media is understandably delighted to be reporting some good news, and the coverage is downright giddy — thanks, in great part, to interviewees in the UAE itself mirroring the Israeli delight.*

The Abraham Accord makes at least makes two political winners of Donald Trump and Benjamin Netanyahu in their current ongoing troubles. Trump needed a boost in the polls and relief from the controversies surrounding him. The Evangelicals have come to his rescue once again.

According to the *'Jerusalem post.com,'* *there was a belief by several top Evangelicals that supporting an immediate annexation could have harmed Trump's reelection campaign. If violence erupted in the form of a third intifada [a Gog-Magog war]; [if] Jordan or Egypt broke their peace treaties with the Jewish state; or Israel faced harsh international sanctions or was put at risk in another way, then annexation could have appeared to be "just another reckless move" by the president.*

This Evangelical ideology influencing Trump comes from a misunderstanding of Jesus' words. Joel Rosenberg said in this *'Jerusalem Post'* article, *"Evangelicals want Israel to be safer, stronger and more peaceful, not necessarily bigger."*



*“A lot of people think they know what Evangelicals want.... There are all of these conspiracy theories about why Evangelicals support Israel. But ...while most Evangelicals believe that Bible prophecy indicates that one day Israel will have all the land that was promised to Abraham in the Bible, what Evangelicals want is what is best for Israel – and their faith dictates that peace is what Israel needs most.”*

**“Blessed are the peacemakers,”** Jesus told the Christians. The Apostle Paul said that, **“if possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.”** Every day, Evangelical Christians around the world pray for the peace of Jerusalem”.

The doctrine of world peace at all costs, and the Christian false doctrine that says Christians get to go to heaven while the Jews inherit the Promised Land, plays right into the Antichrist’s hands. Jesus also said to be wise as a serpent, though harmless as a dove -(Matthew 10:16). Evangelicals are unwise to pursue this “peace” without understanding the difference between modern Israel and Biblical Israel.

Biblical Israel was created with the premise that there would always be 12 tribes in Israel and that all 12 tribes will inherit that Land. Nowhere in Scripture is the idea that some of God’s people will inherit Heaven while others inherit the Land of Israel!

Nonetheless, Trump has won back his Evangelical electoral base in this election year. Will it help him win the election? We will know by November. For now, however, Trump and Netanyahu, the two peas in the pod, are happy at the moment.

The *‘Jewish Telegraph Agency’* says this Abraham Accord makes Trump a winner in an election year. Since his first presidential campaign, Trump has promised to deliver a peace deal for Israel, and has expended effort into reaching an Israeli-Palestinian accord, to no avail. Although this isn’t the deal he initially wanted, now he can legitimately claim credit for helping achieve a historic Israeli treaty.

In Trump-speak, this is a clear win. And it’s a boon for Jared Kushner, a top adviser and his son-in-law, who has succeeded here after failing to secure an Israeli-Palestinian peace deal and drawing criticism for his management of the coronavirus response.

It’s also helpful for Trump in an election year. In a campaign where Israel has come up repeatedly, Trump can position himself not just as a staunch ally of the Netanyahu government, but as a regional peacemaker. It’s not likely to shift votes, though. Trump voters already see him as pro-Israel and probably haven’t changed their minds, while those who oppose the incumbent generally dislike him on issues that range far from the Middle East.

The coming Jewish Antichrist is a political and technological conqueror, not a military one (also Israeli High-tech Firms make good money in Dubai but don’t want to talk about it). He doesn’t have to be a military conqueror because ahead, in addition to Israel’s technological rise in the world and the adeptness of Israel’s politicians,

particularly Benjamin Netanyahu, the Jewish Antichrist now has an army of violent people being trained around the globe to do exactly what Jesus said would happen and they are coming out of that other horn, the second beast of Revelation 13.

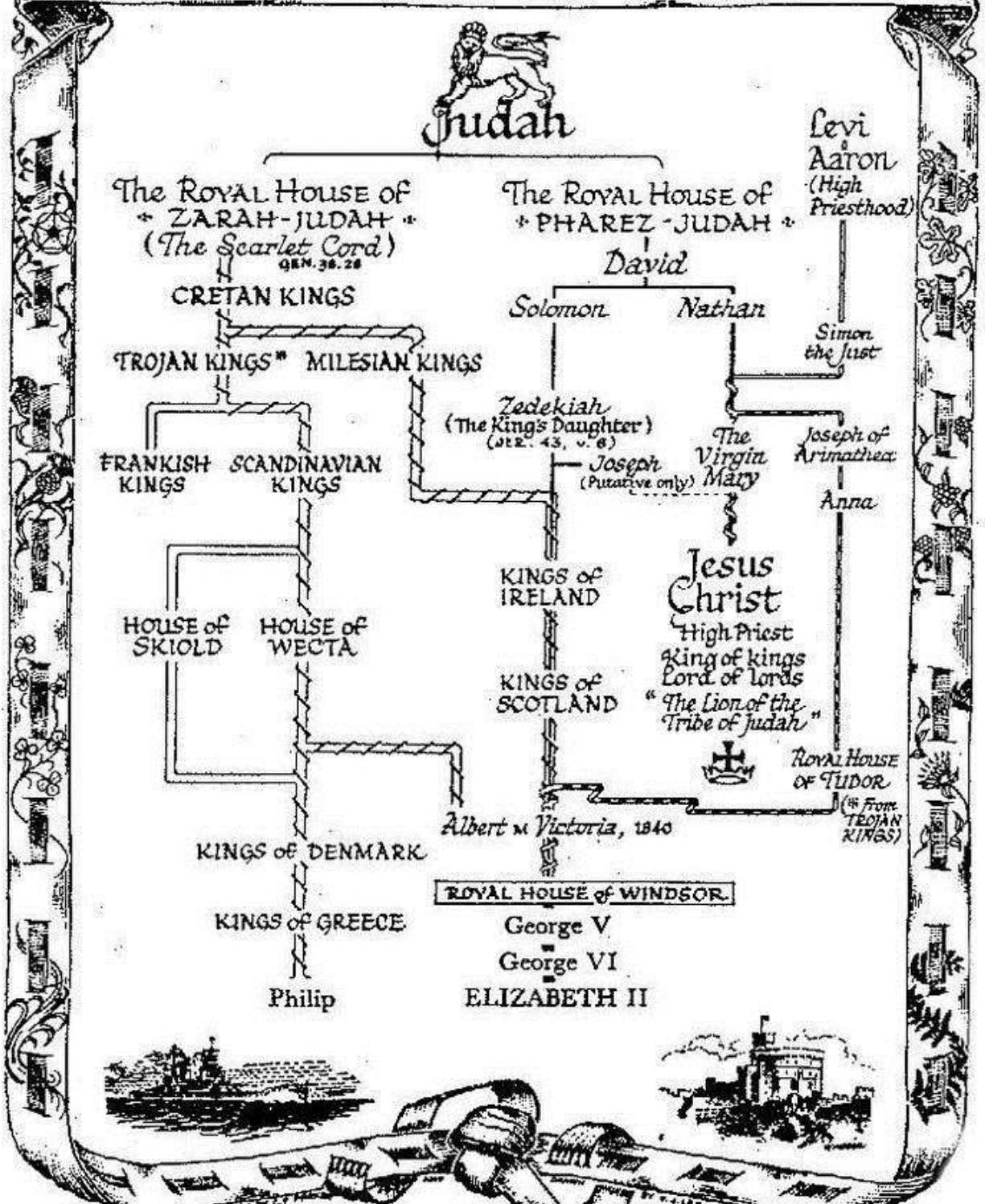
The *'Jerusalem Post'* asks this question: Which came first, the chicken or the egg? The peace deal or the arms sale?

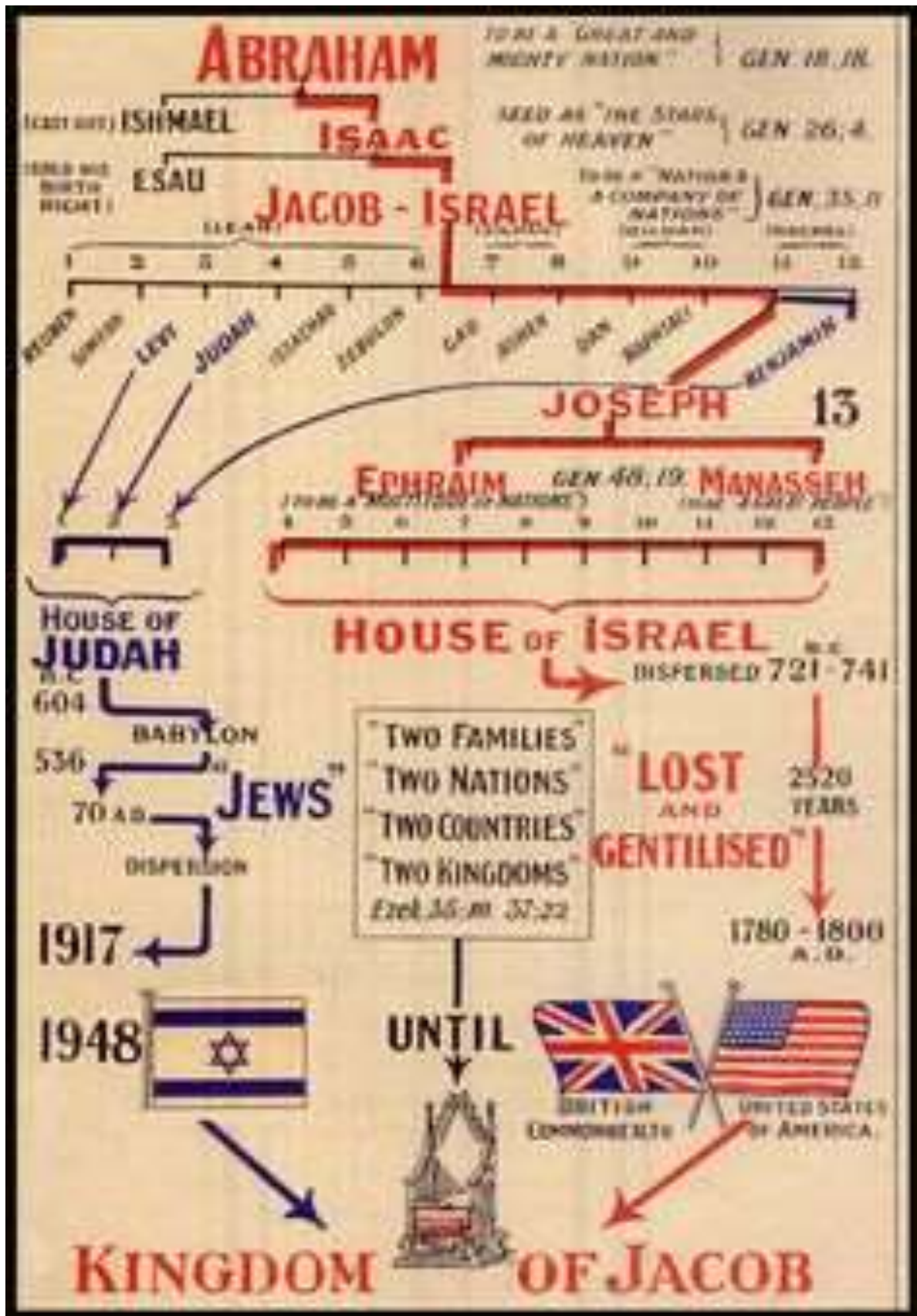

The Antichrist [Prince Charles of Wales] will be an even more charismatic character than either Benjamin Netanyahu or Donald Trump. People are deceived by charisma because charisma is the “lying face”. Jesus Christ was not charismatic in our way of thinking. People come to Him because they are seeking the Kingdom. People turn toward the charismatic characters because they desire being lied to -(2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 4:3). Prince Charles of Wales is the world’s most popular celebrity world leader among world leaders. The Prince is a gifted word smith of the tongue!

The coming Jewish Antichrist will confirm the Abraham Accord. But why? Because he has to reassure the Gulf States, when he takes office, that he won’t do annexation of the Jordan valley or west bank. It will be an updated version of the 1993 Oslo Accords. He will eventually go ahead with annexation, but he will lie to the signers of the Abraham Accord and to Jordan and Egypt at first. He will have to put off annexation in order to begin the process of implementing Jewish Supremacy via the Talmud around the world starting in Jerusalem. To that end, the Antichrist will say that people must choose to either convert to Judaism outright or agree to become one of the subset population of Judaism, i.e., Noahides.

Here is one possibility. The current turmoil in the Israeli government could be the driving force behind that. Israeli elections always loom over Israel now because even with this new unity government there are problems. Benjamin Netanyahu almost called new elections this past week over the budget problems. He compromised, instead, but everyone knows that elections still hang like a dark cloud over Israel. Israel has not had

peace internally or externally ever since the Jews defied God's definition of a Jubilee in the year that they declared the Jubilee in 2017-2018 then proceeded to make Israel a "tribe of Judah" only State in July 2018. This will continue until God brings the Antichrist's punishment intended for the brethren who are non-Jews upon the Jews.

Elections, COVID-19, the ongoing civil issue between Israel as a secular State or Israel as a religious State, Netanyahu's ongoing corruption trials and the constant threat of war with Iran all contribute to chaos in Israel that could result in a new form of government – a monarchy.

And wouldn't it be just like Benjamin Netanyahu to tout such a change by being in the forefront of what he could see as another "unity government" without Benny Gantz? Imagine this: Netanyahu wants to get out from under Gantz and the deal he made with Gantz. Is it possible Netanyahu could make a deal with the man the Jews want to reveal as their messiah, and who will sit on God's throne on the Temple Mount showing himself to be god and king?

Now, leaving the possibilities of how the Antichrist may rise, let's take a look at the new political world we now have in the Middle East and we'll see how this fits Bible prophecy.

The U.S. new position in the Middle East is that it now has two peace partners there – Israel and the UAE. In fact, it was the ongoing threat from Iran's 4+2 Coalition that triggered the UAE to throw the Palestinians under the bus in order to get its own protection.

The Council on Foreign Relations spells it out this way: An important component of the Abraham Accord, though not specifically spelled out, is enhanced security cooperation against regional threats, especially from Iran and its proxies.

The *'Jerusalem Post'* reports that Eytan Meir, Director of External Relations & Development ...called on the Israeli government to use the agreement to further Israel's interests. *"Just like this agreement negated the misguided "land for peace" notion championed by the architects of the Oslo Accords, so too we need to negate the misguided "we can't have peace if we upset the status quo on the Temple Mount" notion and allow for Jewish prayer on the Temple Mount"*.

This will be used to further develop the Jewish temple. Meir also said, *"At the same time, we call on the Prime Minister not to give up on applying sovereignty over Judea & Samaria and the Jordan Valley. It is our historic right and now is the time to implement it."*

Israel will return later to the annexation issue approximately in the first half of the covenant with the many with the Antichrist running Israel as its King. This may or may not cause the war on Israel's soil as Ezekiel 38/39 describes.

The Abraham Accord pays big political dividends, according to this *'Jerusalem Post'* article. The rider of the white horse in Revelation 6:2 carries a bow with no arrows. He is a 'politician', a smooth talker and this Abraham Accord is his big political victory, the victory that starts to clear the way for his revealing.

Netanyahu can insist this is a model for future agreements, "*peace for peace*" not "*land for peace*," which he rejects. The Emiratis can get the jets and drones they want, and Donald Trump will host a pre-election White House signing ceremony where he can again declare he has brought lasting peace to the Holy Land so revered by his Evangelical base and deep pockets Zionist Jewish donors.

This *'Haaretz'* podcaster said Israel will have to now consider UAE and other Gulf countries when making changes to the status quo on Temple Mount. Jesus said the Temple Mount will be trampled by the nations in Revelation 11:2. How might this come about? By Israel further doing what Meir said, "*Pressing for more of Israel's "historic rights"*".

It is extremely important that we add here that the modern UN-created political State of Israel has no historic rights because Israel was never predicated on just the Zionist Jews. Biblical Israel has always been about the 12 tribes united under David. That ceased to be the character of Israel under Rehoboam, David's grandson and son of Solomon. He forced the split in the Kingdom and brought it a civil war that is now 2,900 years old. The House of Judah and the House of Israel are still fighting it in the world even though in Jesus these two Houses have been united as prophesied in Ezekiel 37.

The Jews were able to stay in the land longer than the House of Israel. The House of Judah avoided going into Assyrian captivity with the House of Israel because Hezekiah repented for the sins of the House of Judah. But it was only 117 years from the Assyrian captivity to the Babylonian captivity years until God would exile the House of Judah into Babylon. And know this: Nowhere in Scripture does God say that "Israel" exists through the House of Judah, the Jews. And nowhere are the Jews called God's chosen people. God says His chosen people are all 12 tribes. The distinctions were blurred after 1948.

So, how will the Gulf States come to agree to an operational altar on the Temple Mount? By the Jews guaranteeing the Gulf States that all Sunnis will be able to pray at Temple Mount because the Temple will be a place of prayer for all people who can then trample the court under their feet for 3.5 years. Part of the Abraham Accord is the free travel between the Israel and the Sunni States that agree to the Accord. Sunnis will be able to enter and leave Israel at will. And the Shi'ites will not be included in that guarantee. Plus, it is a majority Sunni nation who now oversees Temple Mount – Jordan – and the Abraham Accord will likely satisfy Jordan over annexation even though it does not resolve the Palestinian issue. We will have to wait and see on this because Jordan's King Abdullah has been eerily silent on this issue. It may be that he will require more money for the Palestinians Jordan hosts on behalf of the U.S. in order for him to agree to the deal and not make a fuss. King Abdullah may simply be relieved that Jordan won't have to go to war with Israel over annexation right now.

How will the Jews convince the Gulf States to let them build their temple? By saying it isn't fair that the Jews are restricted from praying on Temple Mount, and that they cannot pray in a mosque. Therefore, they need an area for their temple where they can pray and do sacrifices. It will be a minor issue for Prince Charles of Wales, as the senior Freemason in the Order of the Garter, King Abdullah, himself a 33<sup>rd</sup> degree Freemason, is obligated to submit to the King and Grand Master of Freemasonry. We are reminded that Prince Charles converted to Islam in the late 1990s. This was written about by Daniel Pipes, of the Middle East Forum more than twenty years ago.

In a 1997 *Middle East Quarterly* article titled "Prince Charles of Arabia," Ronni L. Gordon and David M. Stillman looked at evidence that Britain's crown prince might be a secret convert to Islam. They sifted through his public statements (defending Islamic law, praising the status of Muslim women, seeing in Islam a solution for Britain's ailments) and actions (setting up a panel of twelve "wise men" to advise him on Islamic religion and culture), then concluded that, "should Charles persist in his admiration of Islam and defamation of his own culture," his accession to the throne will indeed usher in a "different kind of monarchy."

Charles continues this pattern of admiration and defamation, keeping alive the question of his stealth conversion to Islam. This weblog entry continues to document the topic, starting with a report, "Charles Breaks Fast with the Faithful in Muscat," in the Dubai-based *'Gulf News'*, on some of Charles' activities during his current five-day visit to Oman:

- He toured the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque for almost two hours and "took keen interest in studying various sections at the mosque, including the main prayer hall." As his spokesman put it, "The Prince was particularly keen to come to the mosque today to see the fantastic building and remarkable architecture which Prince was fascinated with. The Prince has a great love for Islamic architecture and I can't think of finer example than this mosque."
- He "spent a considerable time at an exhibition of Islamic calligraphy and held meetings with Sheikha Aisha Al Siaby, Head of Public Authority for Craft Industries and Taha Al Kisri, the Head of Omani Society for Fine Arts to discuss various aspects of Islamic art."
- He "broke fast with a large congregation of people from different nationalities as he sat with folded legs on the floor in the open. He ate date and drank juice at the call of Iftar."

Trump's son-in-law Jared Kushner said that the agreement was called the "Abraham Accord" because it would enable masses of people to pray at Al-Aqsa and to fly to Israel from Abu Dhabi and Dubai in order to do so.

Wrong! It doesn't open the door for masses of people to pray at Al-Aqsa. It does that, but it also opens the door to building the Jewish temple. All of this has the back drop

behind the curtains, appearance that Prince Charles of Wales is in the wings orchestrating an fine-tuning the details and particulars for such an event for which he can sign the treaty of many in Daniel 9:27.



Such remarks will enrage the people on the Israeli right, certainly so long as the right to pray on the Temple Mount, where Al-Aqsa is situated, is restricted for Jews, but the message emerging from Washington is clear: it's not enough to impose economic sanctions on Iran; the tourism, social and spiritual axis between Israel and the moderate Arab states needs to be strengthened in order to weaken the extremists.

There's another Antichrist phrase – the “strengthening” of the covenant with “the many” Sunni nations of the southern and eastern Middle East -(Daniel 9:24)! This agreement may seek to guarantee peace in the Middle East by connecting that peace to Temple Mount even though that has not been done at this time.

Therefore, the Gulf States will turn a blind eye to the plight of Palestinians for a while. The Palestinians will gripe and grumble but will be told (by the Gulf States) to sit down and shut up; you had your chance to have a piece of this pie and you didn't take it. This is a reference to the 1993 Oslo Accords, in which PLO leader Yasser Arafat walked away from a deal that would have given the Palestinians everything they wanted!

Ted Belman's Israpundit website says Kristin Smith Diwan, a scholar at the Arab Gulf States Institute in Washington was quoted as saying, “...*that the agreement also leaves the UAE vulnerable to whatever decisions Israel makes in the future*” implying that Israel was free to end the [annexation] suspension.

And might we add, build the temple!

The UAE's and other Gulf States' vulnerability will not be seen as a vulnerability to them. It will be seen as a Sunni victory over the Shi'ites. This plays right into the Islamic civil war of almost 1,400 years between the Sunnis and Shi'ites. In exchange for getting this upper hand over Iran and the Shi'ites, the Gulf States will likely allow the Jews unprecedented access to Temple Mount without complaint even if the Jews build their own temple or just have an operational altar up there.

Some news outlets report that this deal was made because the original “deal of the century” was a failure. I don't believe that's true. The “deal of the century” now looks too many like a loss leader deal. Some people will take a loss leader, some won't.

What is a loss leader? It is a marketing ploy used to draw customers into the store. You all know about the big box store gimmicks used for Black Friday, day after Thanksgiving sales. But to get the loss leader 65" TV at a bargain price, you have to go inside the store. Once inside the store, folks often will buy something else.

This store's name is the "Abraham Accord". In other words, Trump and Kushner knew the Palestinians would not go for the 'deal of the century'. They allowed the Jews to push right up against all-out war with Jordan only to pull out of that situation with the "Abraham Accord." This was for the purpose of showing the world that the U.S. has the upper hand in the Middle East. The loss leader was control over the Palestinians. The real upsell is U.S. control in the entire Middle East!

In fact, here is what The Trumpet dot com said: Israel has aggressively pushed to implement the first part of the agreement, which would see Israeli sovereignty applied to parts of the West Bank, including East Jerusalem and the Jordan Valley. The loud noise that Israel was about to have Trump's blessing of the annexation of West Bank territory caused a chorus of backlash against the deal by the Arab world.

That backlash opened the door for Washington and Jerusalem to make another offer, one the Sunni Arab world cannot refuse. There came the real 'bait and switch' deal!

Now, in announcing the deal, the annexation plans for the West Bank have been suspended. *"As a result of this diplomatic breakthrough and at the request of President Trump with the support of the United Arab Emirates, Israel will suspend declaring sovereignty over areas outlined in the president's Vision for Peace and focus its efforts now on expanding ties with other countries in the Arab and Muslim world,"* the joint statement read.

The word suspend was deliberately chosen in the text to show that annexation might still happen in the future, but it is off the table for now. And for that act, Israel now has peace with an Arab state.

Annexation – kicking the Palestinians out of Israel and into Jordan – is still on the table! It's been put on hold for the future purpose of giving Temple Mount fully to the Jews for building their Antichrist temple.

Raphael Ahren of *'Times of Israel'* wrote in his piece titled, "Upending Traditional Views on Peacemaking, Israel-U.A.E. Deal Truly Heralds New Era:

Stunningly, Abu Dhabi's groundbreaking decision to fully normalize relations with Jerusalem did not require any tangible concessions [from] Israel. Netanyahu did not agree to withdraw from one centimeter of West Bank territory. He did not evacuate a single settler. He didn't even have to pay lip service to the idea of Palestinian statehood or pledge allegiance to the two-state solution. Satan's brilliance and cunning is masterfully being demonstrated in this deal.

All Netanyahu had to do to clinch a deal few would have thought possible last week was to agree to hold off on unilaterally annexing parts of the West Bank. Not to abandon the plan altogether, but merely wait patiently.

Until Thursday, the 2002 Arab Peace Initiative was the Muslim world's ultimate frame of reference for the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. If Israel is interested in full diplomatic relations with it, the proposal said, it must first agree to a "full Israeli withdrawal from all the Arab territories occupied since June 1967, *the establishment of a Palestinian state with East Jerusalem as its capital, and a "just" and "agreed upon" solution to the Palestinian refugee question.*

Israel did none of the above and still gets to open an embassy in Abu Dhabi, and perhaps soon in other capitals in the region as well.

How are Trump and Netanyahu deceiving the Sunnis into making this deal? By Trump saying annexation is off the table while Netanyahu says it is only temporarily off the table. The UAE is at the Jewish table because of Donald Trump so they are looking to him to keep annexation off the table believing that the Jews will always capitulate to Trump's statement. But they won't. The annexation issue may be quieted for a time but it will come back again. Netanyahu has a greater agenda than does Trump!

Let's put the sudden blindness of the Gulf States into perspective. Psalm 22:28 ***"For the kingdom is God's. He is the ruler over the nations."***

God is orchestrating the time of the end, folks! The Tribulation is coming like a runaway train barreling without brakes down a steep mountain grade like Tennessee Pass in Colorado. Tennessee Pass was the highest railroad line in recent times, the Rio Grande's Tennessee Pass line was the highest active mainline railroad mountain pass in the United States at 10,424 feet altitude. Schedule freight train service on the former DR&G ended on August 23, 1997. I digress in my illustration but we are weeks to months from the beginning of the Great Tribulation and even closer to the Rapture!

Two years ago, nobody imagined Israel would ever seriously consider annexing the West Bank, and now Arab countries are celebrating the temporary suspension of partial annexation as a milestone on the path to peace.

There is a flip side to this deal, you know. Consider this possibility of what God may have planted in the head of Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, the ruler of the UAE. He may have decided that he can control Israel with this agreement. You see, the Sunnis have an agenda, too. They want to bring back the Sunni Caliphate. Jerusalem is the ultimate goal for all Muslims – Sunni, Shi'ite, Sufi and all the other smaller sects, regardless of their continual mouthing about the importance of Mecca. The spirit of Esau in Islam wants Jerusalem because that is Abraham's promised territory.

Esau wants his territory lost to Jacob because of Esau's hatred of the way of Abraham, the Torah and hating Jacob his twin brother from the womb. Esau tried to kill Jacob in

Rebecca's womb! He will not tolerate any claim to Abraham's and Isaac's inheritance from another. But, much to Esau's chagrin, Isaac blessed Jacob with the promises and left Esau out after which Esau lied about Jacob being a usurper. Jacob was not a usurper. He is the one chosen by God to inherit Abraham's promises. So Esau hates God even more and wants to go to war against God, Christ Jesus, Himself!

So, God, or Satan, or maybe both, may have planted in the brain of Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan that this is a back doorway for the Sunnis to take control of Jerusalem and establish the Sunni Caliphate there. This will enrage Turkey because it wants to rule the Caliphate from Istanbul once again. But now, it is possible for the UAE to appear as if it might establish the Caliphate under Dubai ruling from Jerusalem. And, with such an alliance of Gulf States who will all benefit with military hardware and training in its use, they may believe they have a Coalition that can take on the Shi'ites who are trying to establish their own Caliphate.

You see, this family is in the middle of two civil wars – the House of Judah and House of Israel civil war (this one will be fought in the first half of the Tribulation), and the Esau and Jacob (Islam against Judaism and Christianity) civil war. The House of Judah and House of Israel civil war is 2,900 years old. The Esau and Jacob civil war is 4,000 years old. Both of these wars will be settled during the 7-year Tribulation period.

This peace deal stands to unify the Sunnis more closely and in a greater way than Turkey's Malaysia Summit in 2019. Turkey had arranged for Saudi Arabia to be left out of the Summit because Turkey wants to replace Saudi Arabia as the world's Sunni leader. But the Abraham Accord is all inclusive of the Gulf States.

Saudi Arabia's former culture and information minister, Adel al-Toraifi, said it was time for other countries in the region *"to move beyond the destructive discourse of false Arab Nationalism and Terrorist Islamists,"* and called to *"urge Palestinians to drop Hamas's terrorism & seek a modern state."*

Saudi Arabia is now making noises about not signing onto the Abraham Accord but Jared Kushner says their signing is inevitable. Saudi Arabia will likely be driven by jealousy to eventually sign on.

Turkey is not included in this deal. Turkey may keep itself outside the deal in perpetuity. It is more probable that Turkey will temporarily align with Iran and Russia only to find itself further outside and nowhere near in control of the Caliphate when the Shi'ites of Iran make their surprise move to attack Israel at the moment when Israel is consumed with the Gog-Magog war.

This deal is good for Netanyahu and Trump. Sleepy Joe Biden is also in favor of it. This is why it doesn't matter who wins the election. Both will carry through with the deal designed to bring the Antichrist onto the world stage.

This is a lot of information that you may not have heard before, or if you have heard it before, have not really understood how the puzzle pieces fit together yet. It may be that some will need time to digest what is said here. However, it is critically important that you understand what is coming!
