Iran’s parliament voted on a mandate to destroy the state of Israel Sunday, the anniversary of Qassem Soleimani’s assassination. The mandate aims “to destroy the usurping Zionist regime” and “[break] the siege of Gaza by sending basic goods from official naval bases to Gaza in exchange for money or free of charge.”

Upon passage of the mandate into law, the Iranian regime will be obligated to pursue the “Right of return of Palestinian refugees” and the “Liberation of the Golan Heights” by providing “welfare-economic-security and infrastructures.”



The mandate also designates the U.S. killing of Qassem Soleimani as a “terrorist act” that warrants the “execution of severe revenge by expelling the United States from the region and reciprocal measures to weaken the United States.”

Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei has previously referred to Israel as a "deadly, cancerous tumor in the region" that must be "uprooted and destroyed." Iran openly bolsters terrorist groups in Gaza including Hamas and Hezbollah by supplying millions of dollars annually in financial and military support.

In May 2020, Khamenei confirmed this weapons transfer. *"Iran realized Palestinian fighters' only problem was lack of access to weapons. With divine guidance and assistance, we planned, and the balance of power has been transformed in Palestine, and today the Gaza Strip can stand against the aggression of the Zionist enemy and defeat it,"* said Khamenei.

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu responded to the May threat by stating that Israel will have the right to defend itself. *"Those that invoke the threat of destruction against Israel put themselves in similar danger,"* he said.

Iran days ago announced they were enriching uranium to 20 percent at Fordow, is seen as a clear attempt to increase its campaign of nuclear extortion, an attempt that will continue to fail. *"Iran's decision to continue violating its commitments, to raise the enrichment level and advance the industrial ability to enrich uranium underground, cannot be explained in any way except as the continued realization of its intention to develop a military nuclear program,"* Netanyahu said in a statement.

In December 2020, Israel deployed a submarine to the Persian Gulf as an apparent signal to Iran that Israel is prepared to protect itself and its regional assets. The U.S. reversed a decision on January 4, 2021 to bring an aircraft carrier home from the Gulf Sunday, with the Pentagon saying that due to "recent threats" by Iran the USS Nimitz would stay in position. President Trump ordered the Nimitz back to Iranian waters after the Iranian Parliament's decision. Isaiah 17:1-2 and Ezekiel 38/39 looms closer today after Iran's January 3rd, 2020 decision. The European Union has warned Iran's move to enrich uranium to 20 percent would be a "considerable departure" from Tehran's commitments under its 2015 nuclear deal and would have "serious nuclear non-proliferation implications", as the US accused Tehran of "nuclear extortion".

Recently geologists warned of seismic activity boding of a major earthquake soon in Israel. Several earthquakes in recent months have been in the 3.5-4 magnitude level in the Jordan valley near the Dead Sea. Ezekiel 38:18-20 and a number of other Scriptures allude to the destruction of Gog and Magog in a major earthquake!

The USS Nimitz has been patrolling Gulf waters since late November, but in a statement issued on December 31, acting U.S. defense secretary Christopher C. Miller ordered the vessel to "transit directly home to complete a nearly 10-month deployment."

The 'New York Times', quoting U.S. officials, said this move was part of a "de-escalatory" signal to Tehran to avoid a conflict in President Donald Trump's last days in office. I have reasons to believe the mainstream media is being dishonest with the world on this. Social media has shut down the President's ability to speak freely!

However, Miller issued a new statement changing course on Sunday. *"Due to the recent threats issued by Iranian leaders against President Trump and other U.S. government officials, I have ordered the USS Nimitz to halt its routine redeployment,"* he said. *"The USS Nimitz will now remain on station in the U.S. Central Command area of operations. No one should doubt the resolve of the United States of America."*

He did not elaborate on the threats involved. His statement came one year after a U.S. drone strike in Baghdad killed Iran's revered commander Qasem Soleimani and his Iraqi lieutenant Abu Mahdi al-Muhandis.

Thousands of Iraqi mourners chanted *"revenge"* and *"no to America"* on Sunday. The anniversary of the Baghdad drone strike was also marked in recent days across Iran and by supporters in Syria, Lebanon, Yemen and elsewhere.

Trump unilaterally withdrew the U.S. from a landmark nuclear deal with Iran and world powers in 2018 and launched a "maximum pressure" campaign against Tehran, re-imposing and reinforcing crippling sanctions. The original P5+1 was essentially a free pass to Iran's efforts to develop a nuclear weapon.

The two countries have twice come to the brink of war since June 2019, especially following the killing of Soleimani.

Days after the Soleimani assassination, Iran launched a volley of missiles at Iraqi bases housing U.S. and other coalition troops, with Trump refraining from any further military response.

Iran on Tuesday announced it is producing nine kilograms of enriched uranium with 20% purity a month at its Fordow nuclear facility, Press TV reported, fueling the speculation over just how long the Islamic Republic needs to produce a nuclear weapon.

If Iran enriches significant quantities of uranium to 20%, its nuclear breakout time will become "very, very small," Ernest Moniz, who played a key role in negotiating the 2015 deal as Barack Obama's energy secretary told the 'Axios' news website. *"The key question is how much they make."*

"This is a significant escalation," Kelsey Davenport of the Washington-based Arms Control Association told *The Independent*. *"Enriching to 20% constitutes about 90% of the necessary work to produce weapons-grade uranium. Twenty percent poses a more serious proliferation risk, and stockpiling material at this level will begin to reduce Iran's breakout time more quickly."*

The Institute for Science and International Security (ISIS), a top-ranked think tank in Washington that keeps its finger on the pulse of the Iranian nuclear program, tweeted Tuesday that once Iran has enough uranium enriched to 20% purity, the breakout time – the time it needs to produce 90% bomb-grade uranium – would drop to only six weeks.

ISIS said that although it doesn't know how many centrifuges are currently dedicated to 20% enrichment, they based their educated assessment on reports they had seen that approximately 1000 IR-1 centrifuges will be used, at least initially.

With years of experience in analyzing enrichment of uranium by the Iranians, ISIS predicted that the Natanz nuclear site could produce about 15-20 kg per month, meaning it would take Iran about 10-13 months to produce enough near 20 percent enriched uranium for a bomb.

However, a day before the Iranian announcement, ISIS had already predicted that adding the Fordow centrifuges could "double the monthly rate to a total of 30-40 kg per month and take Iran as little as five or up to six and half months to produce enough near 20% enriched U for a bomb."

"With enough near 20% enriched uranium for a bomb, the breakout timeline would be reduced to as short as 1.5 months," said ISIS, whose researchers predicted two months ago that *"Iran's estimated breakout time as of early November 2020 is as short as 3.5 months."*

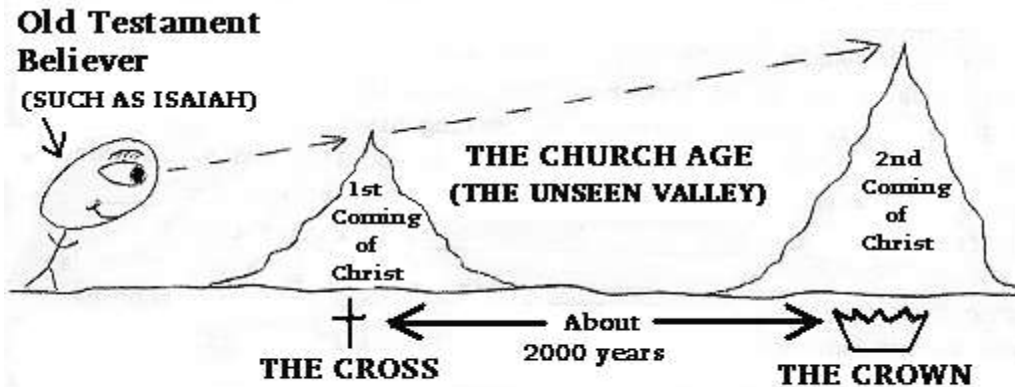
Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu called the Iranian enrichment "a blatant and utter violation" of its international commitments.

"There is no other explanation for this – other than the realization of Iran's continued intention to produce nuclear weapons," Netanyahu said in a statement released Monday evening. *"I repeat – Israel will not allow Iran to produce nuclear weapons."*

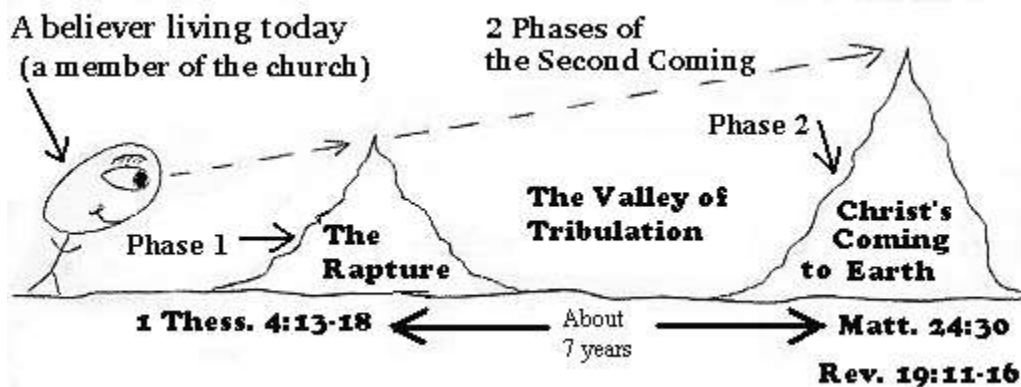

Dave Reagan of Lamb & Lion Ministries in McKinney, TX likes to categorize the prophecies of the Second Coming. He refers to them as: Signs in Nature; Signs in Society; Spiritual Signs; Signs of Technology; Signs of Global Politics; and last, but of the greatest importance, the Signs of Israel. The last category is the big one!



One of the most important lessons relative to Bible prophecy is the need to study the prophetic passages in their totality or collective form. Dr. Ed Hindson, and the late Dr. J.R. Church were significant teachers on the corpus of Bible prophecy. The Bible is a “Living” document, and when you factor in the first few pages of this “Diamond & Nugget”, reading the prophecies noted in those first few pages, is like going to a major league baseball game and reading the program guide of the teams and their players!

These are but a few of the many prophecies that will be literally fulfilled at the Second Coming of Jesus. Many specific prophecies tell of the events to precede His coming. They mention Russia, the Western Nations, China and the third world nations. They speak of the events that will bring all nations against Jerusalem triggering the battle of Armageddon [World War III]. These will be fulfilled with the same accuracy as the prophecies that have already been fulfilled.

Hundreds of predictions concerning Israel, the land of Canaan, Babylon, Assyria, Egypt, and numerous personages - so ancient, so singular, so seemingly improbable, as well as so detailed and definite that no mortal could have anticipated them - have been fulfilled by the elements, and by men who were ignorant of them, or who utterly disbelieved them, or who struggled with frantic desperation to avoid their fulfillment. Jesus is coming again and coming soon! Are you looking for His return? If you are not then you need to read the most important passages about the Pre-Tribulation Rapture:

John 14:1-4;
John 11:25-26;
1st Corinthians 15:51-53;
1st Thessalonians 4:13-18;
1st Thessalonians 5:1-10;
2nd Thessalonians 2:1-12.

If you have not trusted Christ as your Saviour, then you need to trust Him now! You will receive eternal life and the forgiveness of your sins the moment that you trust that Jesus Christ died for your sins, was buried and rose again from the dead. He is your only hope of reaching heaven. If you simply trust Jesus Christ as your Saviour, you can be sure before you die that you will be going to heaven. 1st John 5:13 says, ***"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that you may know that you have eternal life."***
